Spring 2016 Get Your Lotus Out: GYLO 11







The 2016 Spring Get Your Lotus Out event, GYLO 11, had a false start. Originally scheduled for the first Sunday in May, the weather this year caused us to postpone for the first time ever. In a spring that has had nothing but cold and rain, we began to wonder if we would ever get this event done. When we finally scheduled GYLO 11 for the last Sunday in May (May 29th), we held our breath.

As always, the faithful came out. We had 29 Lotus show up, with the same enthusiasm and variety of cars that make this such a special event. Of course, we had Elises. As by-far the most prolific Lotus ever, we can count on a lot of Elises. We also had Exiges, Esprits, Evoras, Sevens... and a 340R!

If you've never seen a 340R, you're not alone. Made by Lotus in 2000, and based on the S1 Elise, only 340 were made, worldwide. While the 340R is road-legal in England, its real home is the track. With no top, nor windows at all, it's a spartan machine. The engine is the Rover-based K-series engine, in 190hp tune, also found in the S1 Elise Sport 190. For those that drove their car on the road, Lotus actually made available a jacket you could plug into the lighter plug, to keep you warm!

As luck would have it, we had good weather all morning at GYLO 11, with temps in the mid-80's, and an occasional breeze. We had a popular vote for 'Favorite Lotus', with prizes going to the following – 1st Place – Rashid Hedges' Elise

2nd Place – a tie, between Mark Chi's 340R and Norm Beaver's Caterham 7

3rd Place - Duncan and Rochel Black's V8 Esprit
